Thrift Store Acceptance Guidelines

Revised 1-8-11

- Habitat accepts items that are in good clean condition and in working order. Based on inventory and need, the store may choose not to accept certain items for a period of time. This decision is made by the store manager.
- We are unable to accept partial cans of paint, poisons, firearms, and other chemicals or hazardous materials.
- We do accept building materials including plumbing (tubs, sinks, showers and fixtures), cabinets, tools and hardware, flooring, fencing, etc.
- We accept clothes, purses, shoes, hats and handbags at our Leesburg, Groveland, and Wildwood stores.
- We do not accept typewriters, satellite dishes, large computer monitors (flat screen ok), computers older than Windows 2000, organs, console tv's or radios, pianos (electric keyboards and small spinets ok), carpet padding (unless new), mirrors without frames.
- Cars, trucks, Rvs, must be in running condition with a clear title. Boats must be on a trailer with title.
- Donations of land, mobile homes, and stock must be referred to our administrative office for processing. Please call 412-483-0434 ext 17
- All donations must be boxed or bagged. All construction related materials must be bundled and / or tied together.
- Donors should have all merchandise ready for pick up prior to our arrival.
